- Courses are free-of-charge to any South Carolina student sponsored by a public, private, or homeschool.

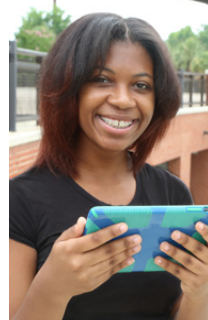

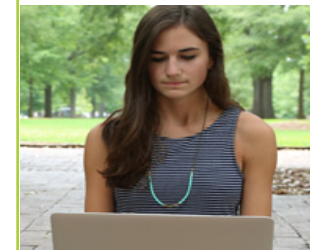
Virtual SC is a free, state sponsored, online program serving students currently attending public, private and home schools in grades 7-12 and Adult Education Programs.
